To Interested Parties:

I understand the Town Board of Lac du Flambeau has called a meeting later this week to help identify a long-term solution to the ongoing road issues facing the Lac du Flambeau community. For more than a year, I have urged you to engage in mediation towards that long-term solution and have offered my office as a resource, including for any requests for assistance from federal agencies. I am hopeful that this conversation will lead to that resolution.

In the letter sent to my office ahead of your meeting, the Town Board describes a potential resolution that would include a contribution of real estate from local, state and federal entities. At this time, I am not aware of a proposal for land purchase or exchange from the parties that involve the federal government. I would be eager to learn more if such a proposal comes together during this meeting or otherwise in the near future.

As you come together in dialogue, I stand ready to assist with any part of an agreed upon resolution that requires action by the federal government.
