Key Factors in Location Necessity

This agency manages the assets of local Native American tribes. The building has multiple departments to provide services in education, economic development, law enforcement, natural resources management, social services, housing improvment, disaster relief, and land and water claim settlement. The BIA Midwest region provides funding and support to 36 federally recognized Indian tribes located in the states of Minnesota, Wisconsin, Michigan and Iowa. During a recent visit, the manager of the building spoke passionately about their belief and mission of enhancing the lives of their fellow tribes. Most employees work in office, but some venture into the field.
